Frequently Asked Questions

Q1 What country does "Asian nation" include?

 \rightarrow A 1

"Asian nations" refer to the counties or regions of the East Asia, the Southeast Asia, and the South Asia.

"Asian nations" are as follows; Bangladesh, Bhutan, Brunei, Cambodia, China, East Timor, India, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Maldives, Mongolia, Myanmar, Nepal, Pakistan, Philippines, Singapore, South Korea, Sri Lanka, Taiwan, Thailand, Vietnam

Q2 Does "Asian nation" include Japan?

→A 2 It doesn't, according to the aim of this fund.

Q3 What visa or residence status condition must be met for candidates?

→A 3 Those who have already enrolled at a university in Japan with a "Student" status of residents (including postgraduate students) are ineligible. Those who have changed their status of residence to something other than "Student" after enrolling in the Tokyo Metropolitan University, will lose eligibility.

Q4 Are those living in Japan eligible?

→A 4 Those living in Japan who are a citizen of an Asian nation or region, with special permanent resident status, or who are allowed to reside in Japan permanently according to the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act are ineligible.
