3 Main Initiatives of TRIS

(1) Research and study based on a request from the Tokyo Metropolitan Government.

(2) Research through internal recruitment

To promote research that is expected to pave the way for a sustainable future society, which is a common issue in global society, through internal recruitment, and to return the results to the Tokyo Metropolitan Government and society through dissemination. (Open call for applications will be made during the fiscal year ending March 31, 2022, and the research is scheduled to start in April 2022.)

(3) Dissemination of results through website, symposiums, etc.

TRIS kick-off symposium will be held in April 2022 or later, and the results of the above research will be disseminated through the website (scheduled to be opened in April 2022), seminars, etc.
