COVID-19 Vaccines on Minami-Osawa Campus and Arakawa Campus - Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q1: Do I need a vaccination ticket (coupon)?

A1: Yes, you will be asked to enter the "Vaccination Ticket Number" and "Local Government Number" written on the vaccination ticket (coupon) when scheduling an appointment. You will also need your vaccination ticket (coupon) on the day of your appointment.

Q2: When will I receive my vaccination ticket (coupon)?

A2: Vaccination tickets (coupons) are issued by each local government, and delivered on different schedules. Please contact your local government for a specific date of delivery. Additionally, please check your address on your resident card. The vaccination tickets (coupons) may have been sent to the address on your resident card.

Q3: When does the vaccination period start?

A3: (i) Arakawa Campus: for the time being, from February 28, 2022 (Monday)
(ii) Minami-Osawa Campus: for the time being, from March 6, 2022 (Sunday)

Q4: How do I schedule my vaccine appointment?

A4: You can schedule your vaccine appointment online via our vaccination appointment system (https://www.tokyovaccine-rsv.metro.tokyo.lg.jp/pages/3rd-shot_venue.html) from your computer, smartphone, or tablet devices. Please note that you can make appointments online only; not by phone or email.

※ Students, faculty and staff who study or work on any of the Tokyo Metropolitan University (TMU), Advanced Institute of Industrial Technology (AIIT) and Tokyo Metropolitan College of Industrial Technology (TMCIT) campuses will be informed of the vaccination appointment through Campus Square and e-mails sent to their respective affiliations, so please check with them if you would like to be vaccinated.

Q5: Do I have to pay for the vaccine?

A5: Vaccines are free of charge as they are provided at public expense.

Q6: What kind of clothes should I wear on the day of my appointment?

A6: Please wear clothes (T-shirts or sleeveless shirts) that are easily accessible for vaccinators to your shoulders. You will be given an injection of the vaccine into your shoulder (upper arm).

Q7: Can I get a certificate that says I am vaccinated for international travel?

A7: Yes. If you need a vaccination certificate of COVID-19, please contact your local government that issued your vaccination ticket (coupon).
