1 Eligibility, etc.

The position for the *Tokyo Center For Excellence Project* is an assistant professor and is open to all young researchers, including those in humanities, social sciences, and natural sciences, with no restriction on field of specialization. Applicants must possess a doctoral degree at the time of employment (including those who are expected to obtain the degree by the date of employment).

2 Selection Process

The first round of selection at the *Tokyo Center For Excellence Project* Selection Committee, chaired by the President, will involve a document screening and select successful candidates for the first round.

In the second round of selection, shortlisted candidates will be evaluated through interviews by the selection committee that includes internal faculty members, who have academic backgrounds relevant to the applicants' field of specialization, and an outside expert. Evaluation criteria include past research achievements, the potential for future research development, and the candidate's capacity to become a leading scholar of the next generation.

Final decisions will be made following internal meetings and other processes.

3 Terms and Conditions of Appointment

The term of office for the *Tokyo Center For Excellence Project* faculty members is five years, non-renewable.

While the duties of the *Tokyo Center For Excellence Project* faculty members are the same as those of other full-time faculty members, including vacations, salary and allowances, and eligibility for the Discretionary Labor System for Professional Services, the major difference is that, in principle, the duties are limited to research. However, if the individual wishes to do so, he/she may, in consultation with the relevant department, teach one course or seminar, etc., in consideration of his/her future career path.

After the appointment, successful candidates will be affiliated with one of the faculties, graduate schools, or research centers, etc. at TMU, but are free to pursue independent research in any field, without institutional limitations on content.

In addition to the individual basic research grant of approximately 500,000 yen per year, further research funds will be allocated as needed. In addition, for one year during the term of office, the recipient will be encouraged to conduct research activities at a university or research institute abroad, with TMU providing financial support for travel and accommodation expenses.
